3) Entrance Sign:

Bob Burpee estimated the current association balance at \$6300, without completing the collection of this year's dues. Cost of a new sign to run approximately \$4,000, depending on choices made. The members present voted unanimously in favor of investing in a new sign. Amy presented options obtained from Columbus Sign Company (recommended by Mike Keegan). 4 options included background materials of wood, high density urethane, aluminum mesh, and stone. The group voted against the wood option as being difficult to maintain. Adequate lighting also is a priority which needs to be addressed. Denise Wollett and Nancy Crocker volunteered to head up the sign committee (along with other members to be added later). They will check with other suppliers as well as Columbus Sign Company, research design options, and report back to the group.

4) Miscellaneous:

The result of Amy's resident survey put "picking up after pets" as the top concern. Larry Focht suggested we get input from Duane Knauer, who is an original resident on Meadowbrook Circle and is very experienced and knowledgeable in the past activities of the PCCA.
